# Ethics Presentation GCEL January 2019

### **Ethics Division**

- Receives 125 complaints per month
- Handles 30 new applications that were flagged during criminal history check
- Handles 40 Negotiated Consent Orders
- Handles 55 Sanction Recommendations
- Approximately 250 cases per month

#### New Cases Opened in FY2017 by Job Role









#### **New Cases Opened in FY2017 by Job Role**

## New Cases Opened in FY2017 Select Group



## New Cases Opened in FY2017 Percentage of Group






